Interview in English (evaluation of the scientific value of the planned work and the possibility of its implementation); **maximum 40 points**

1. Novelty of the project – max. 10 points
2. Scientific merit of the project – max. 10 points
3. Research methodology – max. 4 points
4. Ability to present the research project and participate in discussion – max. 4 points
5. Project funding – max. 5 points
6. Independence in project implementation – max. 5 points
7. Possibility of project implementation – max. 1 point***
8. Proficiency in the English language – max. 1 point***

*** Obtaining a score of 0 points in a given category from all members of the recruitment committee disqualifies the candidate from further participation in the recruitment process.
